Qualifications

- University student, graduate or someone with a solid knowledge of one of these fields: architecture, urban planning, built heritage conservation, history or any other relevant field of study
- Interest in the heritage of our city, its architecture, urban planning and/or history
- Excellent public speaking skills (English or French) and ability to stimulate visitors' curiosity
- Interest in research, ability to summarize and to personalize guided tour scenarios
- Ability to work effectively as a team member

Responsibilities

- Mandatory participation in 4 training sessions and one evaluation (between May 3 and May 24, 2023). The training will be offered in a hybrid format depending on the health measures.
- Based on an outline scenario, complete the research and consolidate it into a guided tour scenario (approximately 30 hours of preparation)
- Be available in July or August to prepare the guided tours
- Participate in group practice visits
- Facilitate guided tours (two or three tours in the season)

- Sharing your passion for Montreal with volunteers from various backgrounds and with many participants.
- Learning about and discovering the heritage of various neighbourhoods
- Developing your public speaking skills
